A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that deer overpopulation
- 5 in the county of Maui has led to a state of emergency.
- 6 Approximately fifty thousand axis deer exist in the county of
- 7 Maui and as many as five hundred threaten the safety of Kahului
- 8 airport. Recent incidents where deer have entered onto the
- 9 airport runway have made it necessary, in the interest of
- 10 safety, that the State take immediate action to replace the
- 11 airport fence and secure the perimeter of the airport.
- 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to make an
- 13 emergency appropriation to replace the perimeter fence around
- 14 Kahului airport. Without an emergency appropriation, axis deer
- 15 may continue to enter onto the airport runway, creating a
- 16 substantial safety risk to airport passengers and operators.

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 to
- 4 construct a new perimeter fence at Kahului airport (OGG), in the
- 5 county of Maui.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
