A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRYPTOCURRENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established the blockchain and 2 cryptocurrency task force to be placed within the department of 3 budget and finance for administrative purposes. 4 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members: 5 (1)Three members of the senate and three members of the house of representatives who shall be appointed by the 6 president of the senate and speaker of the house of representatives, respectively; provided that no more 8 9 than four of the members shall be of the same 10 political party; provided further that the president 11 of the senate and speaker of the house of 12 representatives shall designate one member to serve as 13 chairperson of the task force; (2) The director of finance or the director's designee; 14 A president or chief financial officer of a Hawaii-15 (3)

based cryptocurrency company who shall be appointed by

the governor;

1	(4)	Solicit ideas and opinions of industry experts on
2		additional legislation; and
3	(5)	Submit a report of its findings and recommendations,
4		including any proposed legislation, to the legislature
5		no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
6		the regular session of 2023.
7	(d)	The members of the task force shall not be compensated
8	for their	services, but shall be reimbursed for necessary
9	expenses,	including travel expenses, incurred while
10	participa	ting in meetings and events approved by the
11	chairpers	on.
