### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a strong early child
2	care and education workforce is necessary to support Hawaii's
3	children, working families, and communities. The legislature
4	further finds that the demand for quality early child care and
5	education far exceeds the currently available and qualified
6	early child care capacity of the State. The legislature also
7	finds that disruptions to the early child care and education
8	system due to the ongoing coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic have
9	created more challenges to expanding access to quality,
10	affordable early child care and education programs.
11	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:
12	(1) Establish and make an appropriation for an early child
13	care worker subsidy pilot program; and
14	(2) Make an appropriation to the Hawaii early childhood
15	educator special fund.

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- 1 SECTION 2. (a) The department of human services shall 2 establish and implement a one-year early child care worker subsidy pilot program. 3 4 The department of human services shall develop 5 standards and qualifications for participation in the pilot 6 program by early childhood educators, which at a minimum shall 7 require that the: 8 Pilot program serve five per cent of the early (1)9 childhood educators in the State; 10 (2) Early childhood educators not be employed by the 11 department of education, executive office on early 12 learning, or State public charter school commission; 13 (3) Early childhood educators include those working in 14 rural areas and child care deserts; and 15 (4)Early childhood educators who apply for participation 16 in the pilot program be selected by lottery. 17 The department of human services shall establish best
- (d) The department of human services shall submit a reporton the pilot program, including any proposed legislation, to the

practices to bring all early childhood educators' pay to, at a

minimum, \$17.00 per hour.

- 3 (e) For the purpose of this section, "child care desert"
- 4 means any geographic area where child care supply meets less
- 5 than one-third of the potential demand.
- 6 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 9 the early child care worker subsidy pilot program.
- 10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 11 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 15 the Hawaii early childhood educator special fund established
- 16 pursuant to section 302L-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
- 18 office on early learning for the purposes of the Hawaii early
- 19 childhood educator stipend program established pursuant to
- 20 section 302L-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

- 1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 2 provided that sections 3 and 4 of this Act shall take effect on
- 3 July 1, 2022; provided further that section 2 of this Act shall

4 be repealed on July 1, 2023.
