BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 The hourly wage [of] required to be paid to a tipped 4 employee [may be deemed to be increased on account of tips if 5 the employee is paid not less than: 6 (1) 25 cents; 7 (2) 50 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2015; and 8 (3) 75 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2016, 9 below the applicable minimum wage by the employee's employer and 10 the combined amount the employee receives from the employee's 11 employer and in tips is at least 50 cents more than the 12 applicable minimum wage; provided that beginning January 1, 13 2015, the combined amount the employee receives from the 14 employee's employer and in tips is at least \$7.00 more than the 15 applicable minimum wage.] shall be no less than the wage set

forth in subsection (a) and shall be in addition to all tips."
