A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 4 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 5 6 than: 7 \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 8 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 9 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 10 (4)\$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 11 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; and 12 (6) 13 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018. (7) The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to 14 (b) 15 be increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 16 than: 17 (1) 25 cents;
