A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FURLOUGH AND DRUG TREATMENT PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
4 create and fund:

- 5 (1) New and existing community-based furlough programs;
6 (2) Residential drug treatment, therapeutic living, and
7 mental health programs that allow judiciary-involved
8 women to bring their minor children into the program
9 to reduce the risks of trauma and multigenerational
10 incarceration; and
11 (3) A comprehensive data base regarding justice-involved
12 women and their families to better inform decisions
13 regarding diversion from prison, rehabilitation in
14 prison, and transition out of prison.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
16 the purposes of this Act.
