A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to decrease the
- 2 maximum number of members on the state highway safety council
- 3 that are appointed by the governor from twenty to ten.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 286-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 "\$286-5 State highway safety council. There is
- 7 established the Hawaii highway safety council. The director of
- 8 transportation shall serve as its chairperson. The following or
- 9 their designated representatives shall be members of the
- 10 council: the chief justice, the attorney general, the director
- 11 of health, the superintendent of education, the president of the
- 12 University of Hawaii, the chairperson of each of the county
- 13 highway safety councils established under section 286-6, and not
- 14 more than [twenty] ten other persons who shall be appointed by
- 15 the governor on the basis of their interest in highway safety.

- 1 The state highway safety council shall advise the governor
- 2 on matters relating to the programs and activities of the State
- 3 in the field of highway safety.
- 4 The members of the council shall serve without pay but
- 5 shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses while
- 6 attending meetings and while in discharge of their duties."
- 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
