A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVANCING CIVIC ENGAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that civic engagement
- 2 provides an opportunity for residents to become involved with
- 3 improving their local communities and neighborhoods. In 2021,
- 4 the Hawaii supreme court enacted Rule 23 to establish the
- 5 commission to promote and advance civic education (PACE
- $\mathbf{6}$ commission). One of the main functions of the PACE commission
- 7 is to provide leadership, oversight, and initiatives to increase
- 8 civic education in the community and at schools, increase
- 9 citizens' knowledge about government, and promote informed
- 10 participation in government and democracy in Hawaii.
- 11 The legislature further finds that the public access room,
- 12 an office under the legislative reference bureau, provides the
- 13 public with information, equipment, facilities, and services to
- 14 assist in research activities, educational outreach, and public
- 15 engagement related to work with the legislature. The
- 16 legislature additionally finds that the public access room is
- 17 well-positioned to further civic engagement with the legislature

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- 1 in Hawaii's schools. However, the public access room currently
- 2 lacks resources to provide outreach services in addition to its
- 3 current responsibilities.
- 4 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to provide one
- 5 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position in the public access
- 6 room to provide educational outreach and engagement with all
- 7 schools in the State.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 11 the creation of one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position
- 12 within the public access room to provide educational outreach
- 13 and engagement with all schools in the State.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the legislative
- 15 reference bureau for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
