
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that improving public
2 health is a complex issue that requires an examination of the
3 social determinants that may impact whether a community has
4 continuous access to health care resources. Coordinated efforts
5 at all levels is necessary to support this important
6 examination. The establishment of a strong health network based
7 in Hawaii county would allow the county to serve as a model of
8 collaboration for other areas. The success of such a health
9 network would result in Hawaii county being able to efficiently
10 develop a ten-year health care plan, including preventative and
11 primary health care, specialty care, and urgent and emergency
12 care.

13 The purpose of this Act is to:

- 14 (1) Require the office of primary care and rural health to
15 facilitate discussions with key community health and
16 social service organizations within Hawaii county to
17 collaboratively address the health and wellness needs



1 of the most vulnerable by aligning the goals and
2 objectives of key organizations into a 2030 one shared
3 health vision plan; and

4 (2) Require a report to the legislature.

5 SECTION 2. (a) The office of primary care and rural
6 health shall initiate a 2030 one shared health vision plan. A
7 pilot program shall be conducted in Hawaii county.

8 (b) The office of primary care and rural health shall
9 facilitate discussions with key community health and social
10 service organizations within Hawaii county to address the health
11 and wellness needs of the most vulnerable by aligning the goals
12 and objectives of appropriate community service providers.

13 (c) The office of primary care and rural health shall
14 submit a report on the 2030 one shared health vision plan for
15 Hawaii county, including any proposed long-term legislative
16 grant-in-aid requests, to the legislature no later than twenty
17 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2023.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
