A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish and
2 fund two positions related to agriculture education and
3 implementation.

4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for one
7 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent position of school
8 garden specialist to be placed within the department of
9 education's office of curriculum and instructional design;
10 provided that the funds may also be used for expenses related to
11 procuring consultants, supplies, travel, and communications.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
13 education for the purposes of this section.

14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for one
17 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent position of agriculture




