BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 4 acreage of land used primarily for a farming operation, as

- 6 land used for farm buildings and dwellings and roads and
- 7 irrigation infrastructure associated with the agricultural
- 8 land."

- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 13 the department of the attorney general to establish a statewide
- 14 agricultural theft task force to provide law enforcement with
- 15 tools necessary to identify agricultural theft perpetrators.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 17 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 19 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 20 begun before its effective date.
