A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMES ON AGRICULTURAL LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. Chapter 708, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
3	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
4	and to read as follows:
5	"§708- Mandatory minimum terms of imprisonment for
6	offenses committed on agricultural lands. (1) Notwithstanding
7	any other law to the contrary, the court shall sentence a persor
8	convicted of an offense under part II, III, or IV of this
9	chapter that is committed while on agricultural land to a
10	mandatory minimum term of imprisonment.
11	(2) The mandatory minimum term of imprisonment shall have
12	a minimum length of imprisonment as follows:
13	(a) For a class B felonyninety days;
14	(b) For a class C felonysixty days;
15	(c) For a misdemeanorthirty days; and
16	(d) For a petty misdemeanorseven days.

- 1 (3) As used in this section, "agricultural land" means any
- 2 acreage of land used primarily for a farming operation, as
- 3 defined in section 165-2; provided that the term shall include
- 4 land used for farm buildings and dwellings and roads and
- 5 irrigation infrastructure associated with the agricultural
- 6 land."
- 7 PART II
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 11 the department of the attorney general to establish a statewide
- 12 agricultural theft task force to provide law enforcement with
- 13 tools necessary to identify agricultural theft perpetrators.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 18 begun before its effective date.
- 19 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 30, 2075.
