
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO JOINT CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR LISTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's
2 procurement process requires clear legislative direction to
3 award contracts to responsible bidders and to minimize protests
4 on bids due to the subcontractor listing requirement under
5 section 103D-302(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

6 SECTION 2. Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

8 "(b) An invitation for bids shall be issued, and shall
9 include a purchase description and all contractual terms and
10 conditions applicable to the procurement. If the invitation for
11 bids is for construction, it shall specify that all bids that
12 include the engagement of a contractor, or contractors
13 submitting a bid with another contractor as a joint contractor,
14 or subcontractor in the performance of the contract shall
15 include the name of each person or firm to be engaged by the
16 bidder as a [~~joint~~] contractor or subcontractor [~~in the~~
17 ~~performance of the contract~~] and the nature and scope of the



1 work to be performed by each[-]; provided that the name and
2 information of the contractor, joint contractor, or
3 subcontractor who is not required to be licensed under chapter
4 444 in the performance of the contract are not to be required to
5 be included in bids. Construction bids that do not comply with
6 this requirement may be accepted if acceptance is in the best
7 interest of the State and the value of the work to be performed
8 by the [~~joint~~] contractor or subcontractor is equal to or less
9 than one per cent of the total bid amount."

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
