A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO JOINT CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR LISTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's
- 2 procurement process requires clear legislative direction to
- 3 award contracts to responsible bidders and to minimize protests
- 4 on bids due to the subcontractor listing requirement under
- 5 section 103D-302(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 8 "(b) An invitation for bids shall be issued, and shall
- 9 include a purchase description and all contractual terms and
- 10 conditions applicable to the procurement. If the invitation for
- 11 bids is for construction, it shall specify that all bids that
- 12 include the engagement of a contractor or subcontractor in the
- 13 performance of the contract shall include the name of each
- 14 person or firm to be engaged by the bidder as a [joint]
- 15 contractor or subcontractor [in the performance of the contract]
- 16 and the nature [and], scope, and specialty or specialties of the
- 17 work to be performed by each. Construction bids that do not

- 1 comply with this requirement may be accepted if acceptance is in
- 2 the best interest of the State and the value of the work to be
- 3 performed by the [joint] contractor or subcontractor is equal to
- 4 or less than one per cent of the total bid amount."
- 5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
