#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 201-113, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 3 "§201-113 Hawaii film and creative industries development special fund.
