A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARRIAGE LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 211, Session

 Laws of Hawaii 2021, authorized the issuance of a civil license

 solemnize marriages. Prior to enactment, only individuals
- 4 with religious affiliations or judicial appointments could
- 5 obtain a license to solemnize marriages.
- 6 Act 211, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, also established fees
- 7 for a civil license to solemnize marriages, the intent of which
- 8 was to enhance general revenues from approximately twenty
- 9 thousand marriages per year, two-thirds of which are for out-of-
- $10\,$ state and international couples. However, there are no fees for
- 11 licenses to solemnize marriages applicable to religious and
- 12 judicial marriage solemnizers.
- The purpose of this Act is to:
- 14 (1) Establish a \$25 fee for all licenses to solemnize a
- marriage to be deposited into the vital statistics
- improvement special fund;

1	(2)	Require the department of health to account for the
2		collection and deposit of the fee into the vital
3		statistics improvement special fund; and
4	(3)	Repeal certain provisions related to obtaining a
5		license to solemnize civil marriage ceremonies for
6		consistency with the purpose of this measure.
7	SECT	ION 2. Section 338-14.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:	
9	"(c)	The fund shall consist of fees remitted pursuant to
10	section 338-14.5[-] and section 572-11. All realizations of the	
11	fund shall be subject to the conditions specified in subsection	
12	(b)."	
13	SECT	ION 3. Section 572-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended to read as follows:	
15	"§572	2-11 Marriage ceremony; license to solemnize[+]; fees.
16	(a) It sl	nall not be lawful for any person to perform the
17	marriage ceremony within the State without first obtaining from	
18	the depart	tment of health a license to solemnize marriages.
19	(b)	The fee for any license to solemnize a marriage shall

be \$25 per year.

The department shall keep an accounting of all fees 1 2 collected pursuant to this section and shall deposit all such fees into the vital statistics improvement special fund, 3 4 pursuant to section 338-14.6." SECTION 4. Section 572-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 6 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 7 A civil license to solemnize marriages may be issued to, and the marriage rite may be performed and solemnized by, 8 any individual at least eighteen years of age, upon presentation 9 to the individual of a license to marry, as prescribed by this 10 chapter. An individual with a civil license to solemnize a 11 marriage may receive the price stipulated by the parties or any 12 13 gratuity tendered. [The civil license shall be valid for no 14 less than two years from the date of its issuance; provided that 15 a temporary three-month civil license may be issued upon an 16 individual's request. The fee for a civil license shall be \$100 17 per year the permit is valid; provided that the fee for a temporary three-month license shall be \$25.] An individual who 18 19 performs a solemnization of a marriage pursuant to a civil license issued under this subsection shall obtain the prior 20 21 written consent of each person for whom a solemnization is

- 1 performed and fulfill all provisions of sections 572-13 and
- 2 572-15 applicable to persons authorized to solemnize marriages."
- 3 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Marriage; License to Solemnize; Fees; Department of Health; Vital Statistics Improvement Special Fund

Description:

Establishes a \$25 fee for all licenses to solemnize a marriage to be deposited into the vital statistics improvement special fund. Requires the Department of Health to account for the collection and deposit of the fee into the vital statistics improvement special fund. Repeals fees related to obtaining a license to solemnize civil marriage ceremonies. (SD2)
