A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR COVID-19 VACCINATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. Vaccinations are a critical intervention that
- 5 dramatically decrease the health impacts of the coronavirus
- 6 disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic. The current COVID-19 omicron
- 7 variant is significantly more transmissible than previous
- 8 variants. Studies have demonstrated the tremendous importance of
- 9 vaccinations in both reducing the severity of illness as well as
- 10 the transmission of disease.
- 11 Current federal funding from the United States Federal
- 12 Emergency Management Agency will expire in April 2022.
- 13 Additional state funds are needed to support community
- 14 vaccination efforts through 2022.
- 15 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
- 16 appropriation for fiscal year 2021-2022 to provide resources for

- 1 the department of health and community partners to respond
- 2 effectively.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,000,000 or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 for
- 6 surge-response vaccination activities.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
