A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE IV OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2 amendment to Article IV of the Constitution of the State of
3 Hawaii by inserting a new section to provide that, for the
4 purposes of the Article, "permanent resident" means any person
5 counted as residing in the State, according to the most recent
6 census certified by the United States Census Bureau or any
7 successor federal agency.

8 SECTION 2. Article IV of the Constitution of the State of
9 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
10 designated and to read as follows:

11 **"PERMANENT RESIDENTS"**

12 Section . For the purposes of this Article, "permanent
13 resident" means any person counted as residing in the State,
14 according to the most recent census certified by the United
15 States Census Bureau or any successor federal agency."

16 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
17 be as follows:





1 "Shall the Constitution of the State of Hawaii be

4 term "permanent resident" means any person counted as
5 residing in the State, according to the most recent

8 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

9 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
10 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
11 the State of Hawaii.
