A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SALARY COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

3 "(d) The commission shall convene in the month of November
4 2006, and every six years thereafter. [~~Not~~] No later than the
5 fortieth legislative day of the regular session of 2007, and
6 every six years thereafter, the commission shall submit a report
7 of its findings and its salary recommendations to the
8 legislature, through the governor. The commission may include
9 incremental increases that take effect prior to the convening of
10 the next salary commission.

11 The recommended salaries submitted by the commission shall
12 become effective July 1 of the next even numbered fiscal year
13 unless the legislature disapproves the recommended salaries
14 submitted by the commission through the adoption of a concurrent
15 resolution, which shall be approved by a simple majority of each
16 house of the legislature, prior to adjournment sine die of the
17 legislative session in which the recommended salaries are



1 submitted; provided that any change in salary which becomes
2 effective shall not apply to the legislature to which the
3 recommendation for the change in salary was submitted.

4 The governor shall include the salary amounts recommended
5 by the commission and approved by the legislature for employees
6 of the executive branch in the executive budget. If the salary
7 amounts recommended by the commission are disapproved by the
8 legislature, the commission shall reconvene in the November next
9 following the legislative disapproval to review the
10 legislature's reasons for disapproving its salary
11 recommendation. The commission may submit a report of its
12 findings and submit a new salary recommendation to the
13 legislature at the next regular session. The commission's
14 reconvening following a legislative disapproval shall not toll
15 the six-year cycle."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
