BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that providing

- 13 hours were to be used for job-embedded professional development
- 14 to provide benefits, including a formalized structure for
- 15 organizing training and learning time, reducing the need for
- 16 substitute teachers, and eliminating teacher absences from the

- 1 classroom for training. However, because funding was not
- 2 available, the memorandum of understanding was not renewed.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for fiscal
- 4 year 2022-2023 for twenty-one additional hours of professional
- 5 development for each teacher per calendar year to replace the
- 6 professional development hours that were lost when the
- 7 memorandum of understanding expired.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 11 the funding of twenty-one hours of professional development for
- 12 each department of education teacher per calendar year.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 education.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on December 25,
- **16** 2040.
