A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$23,150,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the ninth
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Aina Haina Elementary

8 A. Surfacing, lining, curbing,
9 fencing, and landscaping of mauka
10 gravel lot to a parking lot.

17 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
 18 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 19 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
 20 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 21 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act
3 shall be expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

- 4 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8
5 shall be expended by the department of education; and
- 6 (2) The sums appropriated in item 2 shall be expended by
7 the department of land and natural resources; and
- 8 (3) The sum appropriated in item 7 shall be expended by
9 the University of Hawaii.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
