A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SCHOOL FACILITIES AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1702, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) The authority shall employ an executive director
- 4 exempt from chapters 76 and 89. The governor shall appoint the
- 5 executive director in the manner prescribed in section 26-34;
- 6 provided that [the] if the position of executive director is
- 7 vacant for more than ninety days, the school facilities
- 8 authority board may provide to the governor a list of candidates
- 9 for the position, not to exceed three candidates, from which the
- 10 governor shall appoint a nominee, subject to senate
- 11 confirmation, within sixty days of receipt of the list of
- 12 candidates provided by the board. The executive director's term
- 13 shall be for six years, which shall commence on the day the
- 14 senate advises and consents to the executive director's
- 15 nomination and the executive director shall not be limited in
- 16 the number of terms served. If a vacancy occurs during a term,
- 17 the governor shall appoint an interim executive director whose



- 1 appointment shall expire if the senate does not advise and
- 2 consent to the nomination of an executive director at the next
- 3 regular session of the legislature after the vacancy occurs.
- 4 The salary of the executive director shall be set by the school
- 5 facilities authority board and the executive director shall be
- 6 included in any benefit program generally applicable to the
- 7 officers and employees of the State."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

School Facilities Authority; Executive Director; Governor Appointment

Description:

Authorizes, under certain circumstances, the School Facilities Authority Board to provide to the governor a list of up to three candidates for the position of executive director of the school facilities authority. Requires the governor to select a nominee for senate approval within sixty days of receiving the list of candidates from the school facilities board.
