BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established within the department 2 of land and natural resources for administrative purposes a

- 4 (1) Determine basic shooting facility requirements,
 5 including the type of shooting venues desired for
 6 rifle, pistol, shotgun, air gun, archery, or other
 7 shooting sports on the island of Hawaii.

- 8 (2) Construct a preliminary diagram showing all desired
 9 shooting venues and the basic support infrastructure
 10 required, determine the land size necessary for
 11 construction, and incorporate any safety zones

 Manual" that incorporates the work of the working

 group, including a list and description of the desired

- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 as a
- 10 grant-in-aid to the county of Hawaii for the planning, design,
- 11 and construction of an adequate, safe, and ecologically
- 12 responsible public shooting facility for the island of Hawaii;
- 13 provided that no funds shall be made available under this Act
- 14 unless the county of Hawaii provides matching funds on a
- 15 dollar-for-dollar basis.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 17 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Establishes a working group consisting of the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, the Director of Public Safety, and hunters and recreational shooters to determine potential locations and requirements for a shooting facility in the County of Hawaii. Appropriates funds to establish the shooting facility in the County of Hawaii. Requires the County of Hawaii to match funds appropriated on a dollar-for-dollar basis. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
