A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CIVIL AIR PATROL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that for over
- 2 seventy-five years, the civil air patrol has assisted emergency
- 3 management agencies throughout the nation with response and
- 4 recovery efforts during and after a disaster. The civil air
- 5 patrol is a non-profit organization and an auxiliary of the
- 6 United States Air Force and its missions include emergency
- 7 services, aerospace education, and cadet programs. Civil air
- 8 patrol members are volunteers who serve as pilots, scanners, and
- 9 ground crew in fulfilling its mission.
- 10 The legislature further finds that the civil air patrol
- 11 emergency response and recovery activities have included search
- 12 and rescue, damage assessments, aerial photography of impacted
- 13 areas, alerts and notifications, and transportation of supplies.
- 14 Most recently, the civil air patrol conducted aerial
- 15 reconnaissance of the State after the severe weather incident in
- 16 December of 2021. The photographs were instrumental in
- 17 documenting the damage to roadways on the island of Maui and

- 1 were included in the State's application for a federal disaster
- 2 declaration. Similar missions were conducted on the island of
- 3 Hawaii during the Kilauea volcanic eruptions, and on the island
- 4 of Kauai during the recent flood events. In situations where
- 5 the State is threatened by a tsunami, the civil air patrol has
- 6 been called upon to alert remote areas not serviced by outdoor
- 7 alert system speakers by using speakers mounted to civil air
- 8 patrol aircraft.
- 9 The legislature also finds that the Hawaii wing of the
- 10 civil air patrol has conducted these activities through funding
- 11 of operational expenses from the State for years. However, that
- 12 funding ceased in 2019.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 14 funds to support the operational expenses of the Hawaii wing of
- 15 the civil air patrol.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
- 19 fund the operational expenses of the Hawaii wing of the civil
- 20 air patrol.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
