RELATING TO THE HAWAII BROADBAND AND DIGITAL EQUITY OFFICE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 206S-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$206S-3[+] Hawaii broadband and digital equity office;
- 4 duties. In furtherance of the State's objectives and policies
- 5 for the economy pursuant to section 226-10.5, the office shall:
- 6 (1) Develop and implement specific strategies and plans to
- 7 aggressively increase broadband affordability,
- 8 penetration, and competitive availability in the
- 9 State;
- 10 (2) Support the efforts of both public and private
- entities in the State to enhance or facilitate the
- deployment of and access to competitively priced,
- advanced electronic communications services, including
- 14 broadband and its products and services and internet
- 15 access services of general application throughout the
- 16 State;
