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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$34,688,890 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 twenty-fourth senatorial district, as follows:

7       1. Ahuimanu Elementary School

9           equipment for an Americans with  
10           Disability Act accessible pathway;

9 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
10 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this section,  
11 are hereby appropriated out of the state legacy land special  
12 fund of the State of Hawaii for fiscal year 2022-2023.

13 1. Kaneohe Pali to Loi project.

14 A. Land acquisition for phase one of

18 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital  
19 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
20 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is



1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 4. (a) The sums appropriated for the respective  
4 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for  
5 the purposes of this Act as follows:

6 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1) through (9) shall  
7 be expended by the department of education;

8 (2) The sums appropriated in item (10) shall be expended  
9 by the department of health; and

10 (3) The sums appropriated in item (11) shall be expended  
11 by the University of Hawaii.

12 (b) The sum appropriated for the capital project set forth  
13 in section 2 of this Act shall be expended for the purposes of  
14 this Act by the department of land and natural resources.

15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
