
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 103D-701, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) Any actual or prospective bidder, offeror, or contractor who is aggrieved in connection with the solicitation or award of a contract may protest to the chief procurement officer or a designee as specified in the solicitation. ~~[Except as provided in sections 103D-303 and 103D-304, a protest shall be submitted in writing within five working days after the aggrieved person knows or should have known of the facts giving rise thereto; provided that a]~~ A protest of an award ~~[or proposed award]~~ shall ~~[in any event]~~ be submitted in writing within five working days after the posting of award of the contract under section 103D-302 ~~[or]~~, 103D-303, or 103D-304, if no request for debriefing has been made, as applicable~~[+~~ ~~provided further that no]~~. A protest based upon the content of the solicitation shall be ~~[considered unless it is]~~ submitted in writing prior to the date set for the receipt of offers."
