A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's community
- 2 colleges play a critical role in the economic recovery and
- 3 revitalization of the State, including support for residents by
- 4 providing opportunities to improve their employment prospects
- 5 and developing a workforce that helps companies and nonprofit
- 6 organizations meet the community's needs and survive and thrive
- 7 as businesses.
- Community colleges are at the forefront of post-secondary 8
- 9 workforce development programs both locally and across the
- 10 United States. Programs that are designed to positively impact
- local employment pipelines and provide skills for students to 11
- succeed in jobs that pay not just the minimum wage, but a 12
- family-sustaining wage, are critical to rebuilding the post-13
- 14 pandemic economy and developing Hawaii's future workforce.
- Hawaii's community college faculty and administrators work 15
- with employers, industry associations, economic development 16
- leaders, and community organizations to develop and offer 17

- 1 workforce training programs to prepare residents for current and
- 2 future employment opportunities, whether for initial employment,
- 3 advancement, continuing education, or career changes. Community
- 4 colleges provide workforce training through their credit-based
- 5 degree programs as well as non-credit workforce training
- 6 programs. Hawaii's community colleges also provide
- 7 opportunities for residents to earn industry-recognized
- 8 certificates that are valued by local employers, and which can
- 9 also be "stacked" toward higher level certificates and/or
- 10 degrees.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to utilize the University of
- 12 Hawaii's community colleges as a channel to assist in
- 13 stimulating and revitalizing Hawaii's economic recovery by
- 14 appropriating funds for administration, training, and student
- 15 support for workforce development programs.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 19 the University of Hawaii community colleges workforce
- 20 development program for administration, training, positions, and
- 21 student support.



- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 2 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
