## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRESCRIPTIONS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that allowing post office
- 2 boxes to be used for prescriptions, as long as the physical
- 3 address is readily accessible, would save pharmacists time
- 4 because they would not have to take the required steps to change
- 5 the post office box number to a physical address.
- 6 The legislature further finds that allowing post office
- 7 boxes to be used for prescriptions makes good use of technology
- 8 and a more efficient workflow.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to amend the definition of
- 10 "address" in chapter 329, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to make post
- 11 office boxes permissible if a physical address is readily
- 12 accessible.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 329-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending the definition of "address" to read as
- 15 follows:
- ""Address" means, with respect to prescriptions, the
- 17 physical location where an individual resides such as:

- 1 (1) Street address, city, and state;
- 2 (2) Tax map key number; or
- 3 (3) The description of a physical location.
- 4 Unless the context dictates otherwise, for purposes of this
- 5 chapter, "address" also includes a post office box; provided
- 6 that the pharmacy dispensing the prescription has on file the
- 7 physical location where an individual resides."
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
