A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FUNDRAISING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that campaign fundraising
- 2 events held during legislative sessions diminish the public
- 3 trust.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit fundraisers by
- 5 legislators during legislative sessions.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 11-342, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 "[+] §11-342[+] Fundraiser; notice of intent[-]; when
- 9 prohibited. (a) No fundraiser shall be held unless a notice of
- 10 intent to hold the fundraiser is filed with the commission
- 11 setting forth the name and address of the person in charge, the
- 12 price per person, the date, hour, and place of the fundraiser,
- 13 and the method thereof.
- 14 (b) The person in charge of the fundraiser shall file the
- 15 notice with the commission prior to the fundraiser.
- (c) During any regular session or special session
- 17 including any extension of any regular session or special



- 1 session and any recess days, holidays, and weekends, no
- 2 legislator, or a person employed by or acting on behalf of a
- 3 legislator, shall hold a fundraiser.
- 4 [(c)] (d) As used in this section, "fundraiser" means any
- 5 function held for the benefit of a candidate, candidate
- 6 committee, or noncandidate committee that is intended or
- 7 designed, directly or indirectly, to raise contributions for
- 8 which the price or suggested contribution for attending the
- 9 function is more than \$25 per person."
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
