A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
- 2 Hawaiian home lands often continues to have the responsibility
- 3 to maintain infrastructure despite compliance with county
- 4 requirements.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to require the counties to
- 6 provide for the maintenance of infrastructure for any housing
- 7 development for the department of Hawaiian home lands within
- 8 sixty days and under certain conditions.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 10 by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated
- 11 and to read as follows:
- 12 "\$46- Infrastructure maintenance; housing development
- 13 for the department of Hawaiian home lands. (a) Notwithstanding
- 14 any other provision to the contrary, infrastructure for any
- 15 housing development for the department of Hawaiian home lands
- shall be maintained by the county in which the housing
- development is located in accordance with county standards,



1	commencing sixty days after the receipt by the appropriate	
2	county agency of a completed application for maintenance	
3	request;	provided that:
4	(1)	Applicable meter and connection fees and utility costs
5		relating to the infrastructure have been paid;
6	(2)	The infrastructure conforms to applicable county
7		standards in effect at the time the infrastructure is
8		turned over to the county;
9	(3)	The infrastructure is connected or adjacent to
10		infrastructure maintained by the county; and
11	(4)	The completion of the improvements of the
12		infrastructure is granted approval by the county.
13	(b)	For the purposes of this section, "infrastructure"
14	includes	waterlines and appurtenances; storm drainage, including
15	culverts	and catch basins; sewer lines and appurtenances; waste
16	disposal and waste treatment systems; and roadway improvements,	
17	including pavement, gutters, curbing, sidewalks, street trees,	
18	signage,	road striping, traffic calming measures, and street
19	lighting that connect to county infrastructure."	
20	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.	
21	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
