A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPECIAL NUMBER PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Duke Kahanamoku
- 2 should be recognized for his contributions as an all-around
- 3 waterman, a lifeguard and lifesaver, a swim record-setter, a
- 4 swim and surf instructor, a four-time Olympic medalist in
- 5 swimming and water polo, a sheriff of the city and county of
- 6 Honolulu, an early champion of volunteerism, and Hawaii's
- 7 original ambassador of aloha. Duke Kahanamoku was inducted into
- 8 the Hawaii Waterman Hall of Fame, the United States Olympic Hall
- 9 of Fame, the International Swimming Hall of Fame, and the
- 10 International Surfing Hall of Fame. As one of the first
- 11 internationally recognized native Hawaiians, Duke Kahanamoku
- 12 shared surfing and the aloha spirit with the world, and in doing
- 13 so, brought Hawaii to the world's attention. It is therefore
- 14 appropriate that Duke Kahanamoku be honored with a special
- 15 license plate emblazoned with his name and likeness to further
- 16 promote his legacy of aloha.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 249, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: "\$249- Special number plates for Duke Kahanamoku 4 5 authorized. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the 6 director of finance shall issue to any registered owner of a 7 motor vehicle, who is a resident of the State and has completed 8 the application and paid the required fees, a special number 9 plate for the registered owner's motor vehicle that commemorates 10 Duke Kahanamoku and his contribution to Hawaii; provided that the director of finance of the city and county of Honolulu shall 11 12 not issue any special number plate pursuant to this section 13 before receiving from the owner of the Duke Kahanamoku 14 trademark, Malama Pono, Inc., written permission for the trademark to be used for the special number plate and for all 15 proceeds to benefit the Outrigger Duke Kahanamoku Foundation. 16 17 (b) The director of finance of the city and county of Honolulu, in consultation with the directors of finance of the 18 19 counties of Kauai, Maui, and Hawaii, the chiefs of police of the 20 city and county of Honolulu and the counties of Kauai, Maui, and 21 Hawaii, and the executive director of the Outrigger Duke

9		letters or any other information that is required by
10		law to be on a number plate and is readily
11		identifiable and distinguishable under actual traffic
12		conditions;
13	provided	that the director of finance of the city and county of
14	<u> Honolulu</u>	may establish additional special number plate designs
15	in confor	mance with this subsection and subsection (c) that
16	jointly or separately recognize Duke Kahanamoku.	
17	(c)	The special number plate design shall not:
18	(1)	Infringe upon or otherwise violate any trademark,
19		trade name, service mark, copyright, or other
20		proprietary or property right;

1	(2)	Represent any obscene or degrading image, idea, word,	
2		or phrase;	
3	(3)	Advertise or endorse a product, brand, or service that	
4		is provided for sale;	
5	(4)	Promote any religious belief; or	
6	(5)	Promote any philosophy based on prejudice or that is	
7		contrary to state civil rights laws.	
8	<u>(d)</u>	Each special number plate shall be securely fastened	
9	to the mo	tor vehicle in lieu of the uniform state number plate.	
10	<u>(e)</u>	The director of finance shall charge a special number	
11	plate fee	at least equal to the county's cost of providing the	
12	special n	umber plate and administrative costs, if any, plus a	
13	fundraisi	ng fee to be determined by the director of finance in	
14	consultat	ion with the executive director of the Outrigger Duke	
15	Kahanamoku Foundation. The fundraising fee shall be in addition		
16	to any other state or county fees collected for a motor vehicle		
17	registration or license plate.		
18	<u>(f)</u>	The director of finance may charge an additional	
19	fundraisi	ng fee, of the same or a different amount as the	
20	fundraisi	ng fee established pursuant to subsection (e), for the	
21	renewal c	f a special number plate. If an additional fundraising	

- 1 fee is implemented pursuant to this subsection, the director of
- 2 finance shall revoke the special number plate of the registered
- **3** owner of a motor vehicle who fails to pay the additional
- 4 fundraising fee imposed by this subsection.
- 5 (g) The revenue generated by the fundraising fees, or a
- 6 portion of the revenue generated by the fundraising fees as
- 7 determined by the director of finance, shall be deposited in the
- 8 name of the Outrigger Duke Kahanamoku Foundation in a separate
- 9 county budget account. The director of finance shall determine
- 10 the most efficient means of directing the revenue generated by
- 11 the fundraising fees to the Outrigger Duke Kahanamoku Foundation
- 12 as appropriate to fund swim programs in the State as a tribute
- 13 to Duke Kahanamoku. The net proceeds of the revenue generated
- 14 by the fundraising fees shall be used to support programs that
- 15 promote water safety and swim education across the State while
- 16 developing world class water athletes in the spirit of Duke
- 17 Kahanamoku.
- 18 (h) The director of finance may revoke all special number
- 19 plates issued pursuant to this section if the total number of
- 20 registered owners of motor vehicles that obtain the special

- 1 number plates is less than one hundred fifty within three years
- 2 of issuance of the first special number plate.
- 3 (i) Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to
- 4 any plates issued pursuant to section 249-9.2.
- 5 (j) For the purposes of this section, unless a different
- 6 meaning appears from the context, "special number plate" means a
- 7 license plate that commemorates Duke Kahanamoku."
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
