REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, THE OFFICE OF YOUTH SERVICES, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO RECOMMEND HOW TO CREATE AN EFFICIENT FUNDING MECHANISM TO ALLOW THE OFFICE OF YOUTH SERVICES TO GENERATE INCOME TO SUPPORT ITS VOCATIONAL PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Office of Youth Services provides programs and 2 services for at-risk youth in the State to prevent delinquency and reduce recidivism; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Youth Services successfully diverts youths to rehabilitation programs, resulting in fewer than twenty juveniles currently in Office of Youth Services programs; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Youth Services lacks a revolving fund and may not currently generate sufficient funds to pay for the expenses necessary to operate and manage a revolving fund; and

WHEREAS, a funding mechanism that allows the Office of Youth Services to generate income and use such income to expand vocational programs that create opportunities for at-risk youth more robust to further reduce recidivism and prevent delinquency; and

and Finance are requested to convene a task force to recommend how to create an efficient funding mechanism to allow the Office of Youth Services to generate income to support its vocational programs; and
