
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO NAME THE NEW KIHEI
HIGH SCHOOL IN HONOR OF UNITED STATES CONGRESSWOMAN PATSY
T. MINK.

1 WHEREAS, United States Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink was born
2 Patsy Matsu Takemoto in 1927 in Paia, Maui, in the Territory of
3 Hawaii; and
4

5 WHEREAS, in her senior year at Maui High School,
6 Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink was elected as the first female
7 student body president and graduated as her class valedictorian;
8 and
9

10 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink quickly rose to
11 national prominence as a barrier-breaker and dedicated champion
12 of equality; and
13

14 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink was elected to
15 Hawaii's territorial House of Representatives and then went on
16 to win election to the territorial Senate; and
17

18 WHEREAS, in 1964, Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink became the
19 first woman of color, first Asian-American woman, and only the
20 second woman from Hawaii to serve in the United States Congress;
21 and
22

23 WHEREAS, in 1970, Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink courageously
24 testified in opposition to President Richard Nixon's United
25 States Supreme Court nominee, citing his refusal to hear a case
26 about a woman who had been denied a job because she had young
27 children; and

29 WHEREAS, while in the United States House of
30 Representatives, Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink introduced the



1 first comprehensive initiatives under the Early Childhood
2 Education Act, which included the first federal childcare bill,
3 and also worked on the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of
4 1965; and

5
6 WHEREAS, 2022 marks the fiftieth anniversary of the Patsy
7 T. Mink Equal Opportunity in Education Act, otherwise known as
8 Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (Title IX); and

9
10 WHEREAS, Title IX, co-authored by Congresswoman Patsy T.
11 Mink in 1972, is but one jewel in the crown of her many shining
12 achievements; and

13
14 WHEREAS, during her tenure in the United States House of
15 Representatives, Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink worked tirelessly
16 for the fundamental rights of and equity for women, children,
17 immigrants, and other disenfranchised people, especially in
18 educational settings; and

19
20 WHEREAS, the Department of Education is in the process of
21 building a new high school in Kihei to serve South Maui
22 families, located a short distance from where Congresswoman
23 Patsy T. Mink herself attended high school; and

25 WHEREAS, given her extraordinary dedication to advocating
26 for educational equity and the overall well-being of children,
27 this body believes there would be no better way to honor the
28 legacy of Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink than to have an
29 educational institution in her birthplace bear her name; now,
30 therefore,

32 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first
33 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the
34 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
35 Education is requested to name the new Kihei High School in
36 honor of Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink; and

38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
39 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
40 Board of Education, Interim Superintendent of Education, and
41 Mayor of the County of Maui.
