SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE TO PROHIBIT UNAPPROVED
RESIDENTIAL USE OF FARM DWELLINGS IN AGRICULTURAL PARKS.

1 WHEREAS, agricultural parks are an essential component of
2 the State's agricultural industry; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the primary purpose of agricultural parks is for
5 agricultural production, not residential use; and
6

7 WHEREAS, residential use of farm dwellings on agricultural
8 parks can produce noise, dust, and other nuisances that disrupt
9 nearby communities; and
10

11 WHEREAS, there have been numerous complaints from
12 communities in or near agricultural parks regarding dust, noise,
13 and other nuisances from the residential use of agricultural
14 parks; and

16 WHEREAS, a prohibition on certain residential uses of
17 agricultural parks would mitigate or eliminate the production of
18 noise, dust, and other nuisances in agricultural parks; now,
19 therefore,
20

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first
22 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the
23 House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of
24 Agriculture is requested to establish a prohibition on
25 unapproved residential uses of farm dwellings in agricultural
26 parks; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Agriculture is
29 requested to prepare and submit a report of its findings and
30 recommendations, including actions taken, progress made, and any
31 proposed legislation to the Legislature no later than thirty
32 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2023; and
