WHEREAS, appropriate application of infrastructure investments requires detailed information on the existing load capacity of roadways in Maui County, along with potential areas for improvement; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Transportation Highways Division is requested to conduct a study of the existing load capacity of roads in the Seventh Senate District within Maui County and areas in which infrastructure investment would be most effective; and
