## SENATE RESOLUTION

---

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE  
REGULATION AND LICENSURE OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS.

1 WHEREAS, S.B. No. 1274, introduced during the 2021 Regular  
2 Session, proposes the regulation and licensure of school  
3 psychologists; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, persons who hold themselves out as school  
6 psychologists are not presently required to undergo any formal  
7 credentialing process by the State; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires  
10 certain regulatory measures to be referred to the Auditor for  
11 analysis if the regulatory measures being considered for  
12 enactment would subject unregulated professions and vocations to  
13 licensing upon enactment; and  
14

15 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, further  
16 requires that referral to the Auditor shall be by a concurrent  
17 resolution that identifies a specific legislative bill to be  
18 analyzed; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first  
21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022,  
22 that in accordance with section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes,  
23 the Auditor is respectfully requested to conduct a sunrise  
24 review of the licensure of school psychologists; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is further  
27 requested to submit findings and recommendations, including any  
28 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty  
29 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2023; and
