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# SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTS THE COUNTY OF HAWAI'I TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON  
THE CREATION OF A MARSHALLESE COMMUNITY CENTER IN HAWAIIAN  
OCEAN VIEW ESTATES.

1           WHEREAS, the Marshall Islands is a nation comprised of low-  
2 lying coral atolls and islands with an average elevation of two  
3 meters above sea level; and  
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5           WHEREAS, the effects of climate change such as rising sea  
6 levels, extreme flooding, and drought have impacted agriculture,  
7 infrastructure, and daily life in the Marshall Islands; and  
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9           WHEREAS, the Marshallese diaspora impacts over seven  
10 thousand migrants residing in Hawai'i, of which fourteen hundred  
11 migrants reside in Hawaiian Ocean View Estates on Hawai'i island;  
12 and  
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14           WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic has  
15 exacerbated the public health crisis and other social  
16 determinant of health opportunities for Pacific Islanders across  
17 the State, including populations in rural areas where there are  
18 limited and inequitable access to water, water waste,  
19 electricity, and health care; and  
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21           WHEREAS, to create a safe, inclusive, and social  
22 environment for the Marshallese community in Hawaiian Ocean View  
23 Estates, a community center can aid community solidarity through  
24 group activities, public information and assistance, social  
25 support, and perpetuation of culture; now, therefore,

27           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first  
28 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022,  
29 that the County of Hawai'i, in collaboration with Marshallese  
30 leaders of the community, is requested to conduct a feasibility  
31 study on the creation of a Marshallese Community Center in  
32 Hawaiian Ocean View Estates; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Hawai'i is  
2 requested to submit a report of its findings and  
3 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the  
4 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of  
5 the Regular Session of 2023; and

8 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the County of Hawai'i  
9 and members of the Hawai'i County Council.
