## SENATE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING APRIL 17 THROUGH APRIL 23, 2022, AS VOLUNTEER WEEK  
HAWAII THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

1 WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week was first designated by  
2 President Richard Nixon in 1974 to encourage community  
3 engagement through volunteer service; and

5 WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week empowers volunteers and  
6 serves as a reminder that individuals and communities are at the  
7 center of social change; and

9 WHEREAS, during National Volunteer Week, service projects  
10 are performed throughout the country, and volunteers are  
11 recognized for their commitment to service; and

13 WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week will be observed from  
14 April 17-23, 2022; and

16 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii recognized and participated in  
17 National Volunteer Week in 2020 and 2021; and

19 WHEREAS, ongoing recognition of Volunteer Week in Hawaii  
20 will serve as a call to action for volunteerism and community  
21 engagement; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first  
24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022,  
25 that this body recognizes April 17 through April 23, 2022, as  
26 Volunteer Week Hawaii throughout the State; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
29 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Mayor of the County  
30 of Hawaii, Mayor of the County of Maui, Mayor of the City and  
31 County of Honolulu, and Mayor of the County of Kauai.
