SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT TO
EVALUATE THE OUTCOME OF THE HAWAII 2000 CONFERENCE AND TO
INCORPORATE A HAWAII 2050 CONFERENCE INTO THE DEVELOPMENT
OF THE HAWAII 2050 SUSTAINABILITY PLAN.

1 WHEREAS, in 1970, Governor John A. Burns instituted a
2 conference process to solicit public input for a Hawaii 2000
3 report; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the conference gathered over two thousand
6 residents from a range of backgrounds to offer suggestions on
7 and discuss the future of Hawaii; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the incorporation of public input through the
10 Hawaii 2000 Conference ensured that the resulting report covered
11 topics most important to the State's residents; and
12

13 WHEREAS, the Hawaii 2050 Sustainability Plan was drafted in
14 2008 to align the State's policies with the United Nations
15 Sustainable Development Goals by:

- 17 (1) Encouraging the use of renewable energy;
- 18
- 19 (2) Reducing Hawaii's greenhouse gas emissions;
- 20
- 21 (3) Promoting water conservation and reuse;

- 23 (4) Advocating for waste reduction;

- 29 (7) Promoting pedestrian and bicycle accessibility;

1 (10) Stressing the need for affordable housing;

3 (11) Encouraging a diversified economy; and

5 (12) Supporting indigenous Native Hawaiian culture; and

7 WHEREAS, the Hawaii 2050 Sustainability Plan, while
8 valuable, does not include a similar conference process for
9 obtaining public input; and

10
11 WHEREAS, incorporating public input through a conference
12 similar to the Hawaii 2000 Conference would promote a more
13 inclusive outcome; now, therefore,

14
15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first
16 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022,
17 that the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development is
18 requested to evaluate the Hawaii 2000 Conference to establish
19 and incorporate a Hawaii 2050 Conference into the development
20 process for the Hawaii 2050 Sustainability Plan; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Planning and
23 Sustainable Development is requested to submit a report of its
24 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
25 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
26 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2023; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
29 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Planning and
30 Sustainable Development.
