Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1432, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CONCESSIONS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:


- (1) Increase the maximum term of a concession;
- (2) Exempt concessions for beach or ocean-related recreational services from sealed bid requirements, with certain conditions;
- (3) Provide that a county director of parks and recreation has sole discretion to designate which county parks are environmentally, culturally, historically, or operationally unique for purposes of determining whether a concession at the park is exempt from the sealed bid requirements; and
- (4) Expand the exemption for concessions at county zoos, botanic gardens, or county parks that are designated as environmentally, culturally, historically, or operationally unique; provided that the concessions are

awarded to responsible offerors whose proposals are the most advantageous, rather than solely to certain nonprofit corporations.


