"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT,"

The purpose of this measure is to prohibit lodging establishments from providing small plastic bottles containing personal care products in sleeping room accommodations, within any space within sleeping room accommodations, or within bathrooms used by the public or guests.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Surfrider Foundation Hawai'i Region, League of Women Voters of Hawaii, Hawaiii Reef and Ocean Coalition, and fourteen individuals. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from one individual. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Health, Hawai'i Tourism Authority, and Maui Chamber of Commerce.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:


(1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
