"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TELEPHONIC SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Permit, but not require, Medicaid, health insurers, mutual benefit societies, and health maintenance organizations to cover telephonic behavioral health services under certain circumstances; and
- (2) Clarify that telephonic services do not constitute telehealth.
