Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 2196, S.D. 2, H.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) After January 1, 2023, prohibit the issuance of a building permit for any new multi-family residential building that has ten or more parking stalls, unless the building's parking stalls are electric vehicle charger ready; and
- (2) Require cooperative housing corporations, homeowners associations, planned community associations, and condominium associations to develop plans to incorporate electric vehicle charging systems onto any of its residential properties that are newly constructed after January 1, 2023.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Hawai'i State Energy Office, Palehua Townhouse Association, Ulupono Initiative, Climate Protectors Hawai'i, Pearl
