Your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 2771, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO RISK AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT FOR FEMALE OFFENDERS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Require the Department of Public Safety Intake Service Centers to conduct internal pretrial female risk and needs assessments on adult female offenders to measure the female offender's risk of flight, criminal conduct, or harm to the community, subject to certain conditions;
- (2) Require the pretrial female risk and needs assessment tool to consider factors important to evaluate a female offender's risk of reoffending.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Hawaii Substance Abuse Coalition, Women's Prison Project, and one individual. Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Public Safety.

2022-2549 SB2771 HD1 HSCR HMSO Your Committee finds that a female offender's pathways to crime and risk factors for recidivism are often different than those of male offenders and specialized tools are needed to adequately identify these pathways and risks. This measure supports the use of a pretrial gender-responsive risk and needs assessment tool, which is critical in evaluating a female offender's risk of recidivism and other specialized treatment needs.

Your Committee respectfully requests your Committee on Finance, should it choose to deliberate on this measure, to consider appropriating \$40,000 for a quantitative study on candidate female risk and needs assessment tools.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2771, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Finance.
