The purpose of this measure is to adopt the Emergency Management Assistance Compact in a new chapter of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Defense and Hawaii Emergency Management Agency.

Your Committee finds that this measure codifies the terms under which the Governor may enter into a compact on behalf of the State with any other state, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the District of Columbia, and any United States territorial possession for the rendering or receipt of emergency management assistance. According to the Department of Defense, this measure supports the logical alignment of the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency with best emergency management practices across the country, and moving these terms and provisions into the emergency management series in
