Your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 63, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO NAME THE NEW KIHEI HIGH SCHOOL IN HONOR OF UNITED STATES CONGRESSWOMAN PATSY T. MINK,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of Education to name the new Kihei High School in honor of United States Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Stonewall Caucus of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, Democratic Party of Hawai'i Women's Caucus, Americans for Democratic Action, and one individual. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from one individual.

Your Committee finds that the Department of Education is in the process of building a new high school in Kihei to serve South Maui families, located a short distance from where Congresswoman Patsy T. Mink herself attended high school. Your Committee believes that given her extraordinary dedication to advocating for educational equity and the overall well-being of children, there
