Chairs Luke and Ige and Members of the House Committee on Finance and Senate Committee on Ways and Means:

Thank you for this opportunity to provide information on the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) Supplemental Budget request for Fiscal Year 2015.

Overview

The mission of the department is to manage the Hawaiian Home Lands Trust effectively and to develop and deliver land to native Hawaiians. We will partner with others toward developing self-sufficient and healthy communities. The trust, created by Congress through the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended (Act), set aside public lands to be used for the benefit of native Hawaiians (persons of at least 50% Hawaiian blood). Today, the department is responsible for the management of 203,500 acres of these trust lands, 9,846 homestead leases statewide, and 42,708 lease applications.

As required by the Admissions Act and as a compact with the United States, the State of Hawaii and the people of Hawaii adopted the Act as a provision of the State Constitution and agreed to faithfully carry out the spirit of the Act for the rehabilitation of the Hawaiian race. These trust responsibilities still remain.

The department administers one (1) program, HHL 602, Planning and Development for Hawaiian Homesteads. The objectives of the program are to develop and manage the designated Hawaiian home lands to create more homesteads for native Hawaiians (as defined by the Act), and generate revenues to address program needs. Fiscal year 2014 signaled a

renewed commitment by the State to support the department's administrative and operating costs through a general fund appropriation of \$9.6 million as provided by Article XII, Section I of the State Constitution. This sum is approximately one-third of the department's administrative and operating costs. DHHL has programmed the use of the general fund appropriation to finance approximately fifty-one of its filled civil service positions and the administrative and operating costs to support the daily operations of the department.

Although attrition has reduced DHHL's human resource capacity, it does not diminish our commitment to serving our beneficiaries. The DHHL refocus of its staffing in various activities has minimized productivity loss. DHHL is currently filling critical positions and this is alleviating workload and operational issues that have hindered the advancement of the Hawaiian homestead program.

Impact of Current Economic and Fiscal Conditions

The department has been moderately successful in achieving planned goals set in Fiscal Year 2013 considering the constraints on its operating capacity, the prevailing economy, no general fund support, and the increasing costs associated with providing services to beneficiaries. DHHL's program effectiveness is measured in terms of achieving the overall goal of enabling native Hawaiians to return to the lands, or remain on the lands, in order to improve the conditions of native Hawaiians and to support the self-sufficiency and self-determination of native Hawaiians.

Partnerships with Hawaiian organizations, non-profits, government agencies and the business community provide social, economic, educational, and employment opportunities that support in improving the condition of DHHL's beneficiaries. The department has successfully partnered with self-help housing and modified self-help housing organizations to meet the housing needs of low- to moderate-income housing for native Hawaiian families. In addition, the department continues to pursue innovative financing and renovation programs to assist low- and moderate-income beneficiary families with purchasing or building new homes, rehabilitating or renovating existing homes, or restructuring existing loans to minimize losses while keeping families in their homes. In some cases, without these programs, these families would not have realized their goals of home ownership or homesteading.

Maintenance of infrastructure, which includes clearing flood channels, fire protection of non-homestead areas, roads and facilities maintenance, has increased in costs. Further, certain counties have either not accepted portions of newer infrastructure, or have stopped performing needed repair. Sewers are a specific example of infrastructure needing repair and maintenance. Since operating and maintaining sewer systems is a county function and counties collect fees for maintenance, the counties should continue to accept the sewer infrastructure and perform the required repair and maintenance of these systems. DHHL cannot meet its

homestead production goals and meet the needs of the beneficiaries on the waitlist if it must also continue to pay for maintenance of infrastructure.

In fiscal year 2013, and the start of fiscal year 2014, DHHL has focused on reforming its loans program based on findings and recommendations from the Office of the Auditor's "Audit of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands' Homestead Services Division." DHHL is refocusing on long-standing issues, such as mortgage loan delinquencies and sufficient loan capitalization, which affect the viability of DHHL's mortgage loan program. In fiscal year 2013, DHHL managed a total of 4,891 outstanding loans, issued 27 direct residential loans, processed 557 Federal Housing Administration insured loans, and addressed 728 delinquent mortgage loans. Each of these loans represents an opportunity for a native Hawaiian to return to trust lands or to remain on these lands.

Also, since the Homestead Services Division is the heart of the day-to-day interaction between DHHL and its beneficiaries, in fiscal year 2014, with general fund support, DHHL is digitizing its homestead services documents to increase operational efficiency and program effectiveness. We expect to complete this project in early 2014 and anticipate increase efficiency and effectiveness before the end of this fiscal year.

Continuing DHHL's capacity to generate revenues through its general leasing program and other land dispositions provides a stable and reliable source of funding to sustain the activities necessary to place qualified native Hawaiians on Hawaiian home lands. DHHL is reforming some of its non-homestead disposition programs to ensure the trust earns an appropriate return. DHHL is also committed in its pursuit of energy sustainability as part of its revenue generation and homestead development plan and strives to contribute to the State of Hawaii's goal in advancing its alternative energy initiatives.

While there are tremendous challenges in front of us, the department is positioned to play an integral part in our State's economy through its CIP projects. We look forward to coordinating our efforts with the Legislature.

Federal Funds

DHHL is the recipient of the Native Hawaiian Housing Block Grant (NHHBG), CFDA 14.873, as part of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act (NAHASDA). These funds support housing activities for beneficiaries at or below the 80% area median income. The current sequestration does not have a significant impact to these funds, but the overall NAHASDA program is subject to re-authorization this year. If the program is not re-authorized, or if it is re-authorized without the NHHBG, DHHL will risk losing these federal funds.

Supplemental Budget

Background: DHHL Sufficient Fund Biennium Budget – FB 2013-15

Article XII, Section 1 of the State Constitution requires that the Legislature make sufficient sums available for development of homestead lots, homestead loans, rehabilitation projects and for DHHL administrative and operating expenses. The Supreme Court recently affirmed the Intermediate Court of Appeals judgment, in part, that the courts can determine what constitutes “sufficient sums” for the DHHL’s administrative and operating expenses to carry out the purposes of the Hawaiian Homes Commissions Act, 1920, as amended (HHCA).

October 23, 2012 Hawaiian Homes Commission (HHC) Meeting – Part I

DHHL submitted the first of a two part budget to the Hawaiian Homes Commission for approval. Part I related to requesting general fund resources necessary to address all administrative and operating activities of the department. FY 2013 DHHL budget, adjusted to exclude purposes no. 1, 2, and 3, was used to develop a base.

Also included in Part I were additional administrative and operating costs necessary to operate DHHL with general funding sufficient sums. A CIP request addressing existing infrastructure projects with a long standing history of operational, maintenance and repair issues that have become capital improvement issues was also included as part of the budget request. Part I request was submitted to the Department of Budget and Finance for review on October 30, 2012.

November 9, 2012 HHC Meeting – Part II

DHHL submitted the second of a two part budget to the Hawaiian Homes Commission for approval. Part II related to purposes numbers 1, 2, and 3 of Article XII, Section I, of the Hawaii State Constitution that states ““The legislature shall make sufficient sums available for the following purposes: ... (1) development of home, agriculture, farm and ranch lots; (2) home, agriculture, aquaculture, farm and ranch loans; and (3) rehabilitation projects to include, but not limited to, educational, economic, political, social and cultural processes by which the general welfare and conditions of native Hawaiians are thereby improved....” DHHL request was sent to the Department of Budget and Finance on November 9, 2012. Part I and Part II were recapped in DHHL’s request.

State General Fund Budget – FB 2013-2015

Act 134, SLH 2013 appropriated a non-recurring general fund lump-sum appropriation of \$9,632,000 for FY 2014 and FY 2015 that may be expended only for the administrative and operating costs of the DHHL.

Funding levels and position counts were kept at Act 106, SLH 2012 levels. All positions, other than federal funds, were kept as DHHL special or trust funds. Act 134, SLH 2013, appropriated

DHHL special and trust funds as follows: 1) \$13,030,827 annually for the administrative and operating costs of the Hawaiian Home Administration Account; and 2) \$7,015,612 annually from the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund for personnel costs.

Act 134, SLH 2013 appropriated \$1,000,000 in CIP general obligation bond financing for design costs and slope stabilization of the Papakolea Sewer System Improvements. Act 134, SLH 2013 appropriated general obligation bond financing for two (2) CIP grant in aid projects titled “Waimanalo Hawaiian Homestead Community Center, Oahu” (\$750,000) and “Kapolei Community Development Corporation, Oahu” (\$1,150,000).

Hawaiian Homes Commission Supplemental Budget Requests – Fiscal Year 2015

Operating Budget:

The Operating budget general fund request totals \$27,122,825 and is tied to the administrative and operating expenses necessary to carry out the purposes of the HHCA as reflected in the November 9, 2012 HHC budget request approval.

General Fund Budget:

In Act 134, SLH 2013, there were no general funded position counts in the general fund appropriation. DHHL proposes general fund position counts and full general funding of all DHHL positions, including base salaries and fringe benefits. In addition to the 200.00 position count are 11 temporary positions. In accordance with FM 13-08 budget instructions, the DHHL reduces its general fund supplemental budget request by \$1,395,510 to reflect time to establish new positions.

Summarized below is the department’s supplemental operating budget request prior to the new positions adjustment:

Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget:

The department separated the capital improvement program (CIP) requests between ongoing maintenance and repair projects that are readily identifiable with existing infrastructure and new capital projects.

The existing infrastructure projects have a long standing history of operational, maintenance and repair issues that have become capital improvement issues. The existing infrastructure projects are aligned with purpose no. 4 of Article XII, Section I of the Hawaii State Constitution that states “The legislature shall make sufficient sums available for the following purposes: ...(4) the administration and operating budget of the department of Hawaiian home lands;”. Many of these maintenance and repair costs are typically covered by the counties off of Hawaiian home lands. Therefore, clarifying the line of responsibility between the DHHL and the counties as it relates to emergency repair CIP projects is a critical area to address moving forward.

DHHL’s initial CIP general obligation bond request relating to existing infrastructure projects is made as a lump sum request under the title of “Hawaiian Home Lands Development, Statewide” totaling \$17,300,000 for Fiscal Year 2015. In addition, two (2) new critical repair projects titled “Papakolea Sewer Repairs Ph.1, and Slope Stabilization” (\$13,000,000), and “DHHL Dams and Reservoirs on Kauai, Maintenance and Remediation Improvements” (\$6,000,000) were added to DHHL’s request for existing infrastructure projects.

Lot Development, Loans, and Rehabilitation Programs is aligned with purposes numbers 1, 2 and 3 of Article XII, Section I of the Hawaii State Constitution that states “The legislature shall make sufficient sums available for the following purposes: ...(1) development of home, agriculture, farm and ranch lots”; (2) home, agriculture, aquaculture, farm and ranch loans; and (3) rehabilitation projects to include, but not limited to, educational, economic, political, social and cultural processes by which the general welfare and conditions of native Hawaiians are thereby improved;...”.

The supplemental requests for FY 2015 is the same for loans and rehabilitation projects since no funding for these activities were received by DHHL from the Legislature. The FY 2015 funding request for Lot Development covers projects that can be undertaken if DHHL is sufficiently funded.

Executive Supplemental Budget Requests – Fiscal Year 2015

Operating Budget Request for Fiscal Year 2015

DHHL request changing the means of financing (MOF) of one hundred thirty (130.00) authorized special and trust fund permanent positions and four (4) trust fund temporary positions and other current expenses for those positions to operate sufficiently to general funds. The request for additional general funds supports the ruling of the Nelson lawsuit against the State to provide sufficient funding for administrative and operating expenses.

General fund impact is increasing DHHL’s general fund authorization from \$9,632,000 to \$15,019,204 for Fiscal Year 2015, an increase of \$5,387,204.

The request also includes eliminating the appropriation for DHHL’s trust fund, and moving those expenditures to either the general fund or the special fund. This ensures that DHHL’s trust funds can be earmarked for new development, and to support DHHL’s loan program and rehabilitation projects.

Capital Improvement Request for Fiscal Year 2015

DHHL is submitting five (5) supplemental Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget request totaling \$31,600,000. A description of these projects is included in our testimony and will be discussed in more detail later in the testimony.

Summary

We are most appreciative of the support given by the Legislature to the Hawaiian homes program throughout the years. We again thank the Committees for the opportunity to brief you on our supplemental budget request. We have prepared and submitted our tables in accordance with the format and briefing instructions provided by the House Finance and Senate Ways and Means Committees. Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Hawaiian Home Loan Fund (S-302)

Means of Financing: Revolving Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

The Hawaiian Home Loan Fund was established in 1921 as a revolving fund. Section 4 of the Hawaii Admissions Act (Act of March 18, 1959, Pub. L. 86-3, 73 Stat 4) made the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act (HHCA) a State law by compact with the United States. Under this compact, the Hawaiian Home Loan Fund may not be the subject of amendments that impair or reduce its powers and benefits without the consent of Congress.

Section 4 of the Hawaii Admissions Act, states in part:

"the Hawaiian home-loan fund, the Hawaiian home-operating fund, and the Hawaiian home-development fund shall not be reduced or impaired by any such amendment, whether made in the constitution or in the manner required for State legislation, and the encumbrances authorized to be placed on Hawaiian home lands by officers other than those charged with the administration of said Act, shall not be changed except with the consent of the United States" (emphasis added).

REVENUE LINE ITEMS:

Loan Principal Repayment - Pursuant to section 213(b) of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act (HHCA), any principal repayment arising out of loans from the Hawaiian Home Loan Fund are to be credited to and deposited into the Hawaiian Home Loan Fund.

The Hawaiian Home Loan Fund is used principally to pay the net proceeds when a homestead lease is canceled or surrendered or when a lessee dies without leaving a qualified successor.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213 (b), Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Hawaiian Home General Loan Fund (S-323)

Means of Financing: Revolving Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

Act 249, passed by the 1986 State Legislature consolidated all remaining loan funds other than the Hawaiian home-loan fund into the Hawaiian home-general loan fund. These loan funds were established through various amendments to the Act since statehood. The major source of receipts for this fund is through principal repayment of loans.

The department can make loans from the revolving funds for the following purposes:

1. Repair, maintenance, purchase or erection of dwellings on any tract and any permanent improvements.
2. Purchase of livestock and farm equipment (including aquaculture).
3. Assistance in developing land.
4. Farm loans not to exceed \$200,000.
5. Commercial loans.

In addition, the department may:

6. Use money in the Hawaiian home-operating fund to secure matching funds from federal, state or county agencies.
7. Loan or guarantee the repayment of loans up to fifty percent (50%) of the maximum single-residence loan amount allowed in Hawaii by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, Federal Housing Administration (FHA).
8. Permit loans to lessees by government agencies or private lenders, where the department assures payment of such loans in case of default.
9. Secure, pledge, or otherwise guarantee the repayment of money borrowed by the department from government agencies or private lenders. Money borrowed by the department or on departmental guarantees of loan shall at no time exceed \$100,000,000.

10. Use available loan fund monies or other funds as cash guarantees when required by lenders.
11. Exercise the functions of a lender of money in all direct loans made by government agencies or private lenders to lessees of which repayment is guaranteed by the department.
12. Pledge receivables of loan accounts outstanding as collateral to secure loans made by government agencies or private lenders to the department, the proceeds of which shall be used to make new loans.
13. Transfer into the Hawaiian home-trust fund any available money from any loan fund, except the Hawaiian home-loan fund, for use as cash guarantees or reserves when required by a federal agency authorized to insure or guarantee loans to lessees.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213 (c), Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Hawaiian Home Operating Fund (T-905, T-906, T-915)

Means of Financing: Trust Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

The Hawaiian Home-Development Fund, established in 1941 as a special fund, and the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund, established in 1948 as a revolving fund, were merged into one fund, the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund, in 1986. Section 4 of the Hawaii Admissions Act (Act of March 18, 1959, Pub. L. 86-3, 73 Stat 4) made the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act (HHCA) a State law by compact with the United States. Under this compact, the Hawaiian Home Development Fund and the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund may not be the subject of amendments that impair or reduce them without the consent of Congress. Consequently, the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund is managed as two separate portions, the operating portion and the development portion, to retain the characteristics and substance of the predecessors of this fund.

Section 4 of the Hawaii Admissions Act, states in part:

"the Hawaiian home-loan fund, the Hawaiian home-operating fund, and the Hawaiian home-development fund shall not be reduced or impaired by any such amendment, whether made in the constitution or in the manner required for State legislation, and the encumbrances authorized to be placed on Hawaiian home lands by officers other than those charged with the administration of said Act, shall not be changed except with the consent of the United States" (emphasis added).

REVENUE LINE ITEMS:

- 1-2) Loan Interest/ Investment Interest - Pursuant to section 213(b) of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act (HHCA), any interest or earnings arising out of investments from the Hawaiian Home Loan Fund are to be credited to and deposited into the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund.
- 3) Miscellaneous - Pursuant to section 213(e) of the HHCA, all moneys received by the department from any other source, other than those prescribed in other funds of the HHCA, are deposited into the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund. This includes receipts collected from the Molokai and Anahola Water systems, hall rentals, and homestead lease payments.
- 4) Refund/ Reimbursables - Refunds and reimbursements of expenditures are deposited back to the fund of origination.

EXPENDITURE LINE ITEMS:

(1-14) Uses of the operating portion of the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund include:

1. Construction operation and maintenance of revenue-producing activities (such as the Molokai Water System, and the Anahola Farm Lots Water System, on the island of Kauai) that are intended to serve principally occupants on Hawaiian home lands.
2. Purchase of goods and services to be resold, rented or furnished on a charge basis to occupants of Hawaiian home lands. The department operates a community hall in Waimea on the island of Hawaii.
3. Cost of appraisals, studies, consultant services or other staff services, including those in section 202(b) of the HHCA. Some of DHHL temporary exempt hires are funded from this portion of the Operating Fund.

The uses of the development portion of the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund, which require approval of the Governor, include:

1. Improvement and development necessary to serve present and future occupants of Hawaiian home lands.
2. Improvements, additions, and repairs to all assets owned or leased by the department excluding structures or improvements that the department is obligated to acquire under Section 209 of the HHCA.
3. Engineering, architectural and planning services to maintain and develop properties.
4. For consultant services.
5. For purchase or lease of equipment.
6. For acquisition or lease of real property; and
7. Improvements constructed for the benefit of the beneficiaries of the HHCA and not otherwise permitted in the loan funds or Administration Account.

OTHER CHANGES IN FUND BALANCE:

- 1) The Hawaiian Homes Commission authorizes the quarterly transfer of moneys from the Hawaiian Home Receipts Fund to the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund.

- 2) Any amount in the Hawaiian Home Administration Account which is in excess of the amount approved by the State Legislature or made available for the fiscal period may be transferred to the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213 (e), Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Hawaiian Home Administration Account (S-325, S-326)

Means of Financing: Special Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

In 1959, the Hawaii Admission Act (Act of March 18, 1959, Pub. L. 86-3, 73 Stat 4) provided that ownership of Hawaiian home lands (HHL) be transferred from the United States to the State of Hawaii. The Admission Act also provided that the HHL, as well as proceeds and income therefrom were to be held by the State in trust for native Hawaiians and administered in accordance with the Act, and that use of HHL for any other purpose would constitute a breach of trust for which suit may be brought by the United States.

Section 4 of the Hawaii Admissions Act, states in part:

"(3) that all proceeds and income from the "available lands" as defined by said Act, shall be used only in carrying out the provisions of said Act" (emphasis added).

Section 5(f) of the Hawaii Admissions Act, states in part:

"Such lands, proceeds, and income shall be managed and disposed of for one or more of the foregoing purposes in such manner as the constitution and laws of said State may provide, and their use for any other object shall constitute a breach of trust for which suit may be brought by the United States." (emphasis added).

REVENUE LINE ITEMS:

- 1) The entire receipts from any leasing or other dispositions of "available lands" are deposited into this account. Any interest or other earnings arising out of investments from this fund are to be credited to this fund.

Receipts of this fund are from general leases, licenses, revocable permits, rights of entry, and other dispositions of Hawaiian home lands. The Admission Act and the Constitution stipulate that all proceeds and income from "available lands," as defined by the HHCA, "shall be used only in carrying out the provisions of said Act."

EXPENDITURE LINE ITEMS:

- 1) The monies are to be expended by the department for salaries and all other administrative expenses of the department, excluding capital improvements, in the absence of general funds appropriated for operating and administrative costs.

Funds of the Administration Account must be incorporated in the Executive Budget and appropriated by the legislature before they can be used for salaries and operating costs.

OTHER CHANGES IN FUND BALANCE:

- 1) The HHCA provides that the excess of the receipts deposited into the Hawaiian Home Administration Account over the amount approved or made available by the legislature may be transferred to the Hawaiian Home Operating Fund.
- 2) All revenues from "available" lands are pledged to the repayment of DHHL revenue bonds. Monies in excess of the reserve and debt service requirements may be transferred back to the Administration Account upon Commission approval.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213(f), Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Hawaiian Home Receipts Fund (T-916)

Means of Financing: Trust Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

All interest monies from loans or investments received by the department from any fund (except the borrowed money loans in the Hawaiian home-general loan fund and the Hawaiian home-loan fund) are deposited into this fund. In essence, the fund was to serve as a clearing account at the end of each quarter, all monies in this fund are transferred to the Hawaiian home-operating fund, the Hawaiian home-administration account, the Hawaiian home-trust fund and any loan fund in accordance with rules adopted by the department. Since this a clearing account and monies are transferred quarterly, as required by the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, there are no beginning and ending balances at start and end of quarter. Consequently, there are no prior year or end of year balances.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213 (g), Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Hawaiian Home Trust Fund (T-917)

Means of Financing: Trust Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

Monies deposited into this fund are available for transfers into any other fund or account authorized by the Act or for any public purpose to further the purposes of the Act. Public purpose includes using the Hawaiian home trust fund as a reserve for loans insured or guaranteed by the Federal Housing Administration, Veteran Administration or any other federal agency authorized to insure or guarantee loans. A major deposit in the Hawaiian home-trust fund is the reserve for loans insured by the Federal Housing Administration.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213(h), Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Native Hawaiian Rehabilitation Fund (T-924)

Means of Financing: Trust Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

The Native Hawaiian Rehabilitation Fund (NHRF) was created by the 1978 Constitutional Convention to finance various activities intended to exclusively benefit native Hawaiians. This includes, but is not limited to, educational, economic, political, social, and cultural processes by which the general welfare and conditions of native Hawaiians are improved and perpetuated. The specific sources of NHRF funds vary, but are primarily derived from certain lands labeled "ceded lands" which were conveyed from the federal government to the State when it was admitted into the Union.

REVENUE LINE ITEMS:

- 1) Thirty percent of the state receipts, derived from lands previously cultivated and cultivated as sugarcane lands and from water licenses, are deposited into this fund.
- 2) Any payments of principal, interest or other earnings arising out of the loan or investments from the fund are credited and deposited into this fund.

EXPENDITURE LINE ITEMS:

- 1) NHRF has been used for interim home construction. The fund is reimbursed by private lenders that provide permanent takeout loans (e.g. FHA loans).
- 2) NHRF has also been involved in the financing of community based projects and an education scholarship program within the native Hawaiian community.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213(i), Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Department of Hawaiian Home Lands Revenue Bond Special Fund (S-350)

Means of Financing: Special Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

In 1959, the Hawaii Admission Act (Act of March 18, 1959, Pub. L. 86-3, 73 Stat 4) provided that ownership of Hawaiian home lands (HHL) be transferred from the United States to the State of Hawaii. The Admission Act also provided that the HHL, as well as proceeds and income therefrom were to be held by the State in trust for native Hawaiians and administered in accordance with the Act, and that use of HHL for any other purpose would constitute a breach of trust for which suit may be brought by the United States.

Section 4 of the Hawaii Admissions Act, states in part:

"(3) that all proceeds and income from the "available lands" as defined by said Act, shall be used only in carrying out the provisions of said Act" (emphasis added).

Section 5(f) of the Hawaii Admissions Act, states in part:

"Such lands, proceeds, and income shall be managed and disposed of for one or more of the foregoing purposes in such manner as the constitution and laws of said State may provide, and their use for any other object shall constitute a breach of trust for which suit may be brought by the United States." (emphasis added).

In October 1991, the department sold \$18 million of revenue bonds. All revenues from "available" lands were pledged to the repayment of these bonds. Monies in excess of the reserve and debt service requirements may be transferred back to the Administration Account upon Commission approval.

Pursuant to section 213.5 of the HHCA, the department is required to establish a Revenue Bond Special Fund for each undertaking financed by revenue bonds. A special fund was established for the revenue bonds issued in 1991. Sources of monies for this fund are:

1. Revenues committed for payment of debt service and maintenance of reserve accounts.
2. Interest from investments of reserve accounts.

The monies are primarily used to repay the debt service on the bonds and to maintain a reserve account as required by the bond resolution.

In 2009, DHHL issued \$42.5 million in revenue bonds.

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Name of Fund: Hawaiian Home Lands Trust Fund (T-902)

Means of Financing: Trust Fund

1. Description and Purpose of Fund (including revenue source):

Act 14, Special Session 1995, (DHHL Land Claims Settlement Act) settles all claims made on behalf of the Hawaiian Home Lands Trust against the State between August 21, 1959 and July 1, 1988. It requires that the State make twenty annual deposits of \$30,000,000 or their discounted equivalent into the Hawaiian Home Lands Trust Fund. Proceeds of the fund may be used by DHHL for capital improvements and to meet the requirements of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended.

2. Statutory Basis of Fund:

Section 213.6, Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended.

No alternatives have been considered. This project serves as a health and safety issue, and the Hawaiian community, as well as the community at large, depend on this wastewater disposal system.

A. TOTAL SCOPE OF PROJECT:

Remediation improvements to DHHL dams, reservoirs, and irrigation systems on Anahola, Kauai

DHHL has four dams and reservoirs in Anahola, Kauai that are regulated under the Hawaii Dam and Reservoir Safety Act. There are a part of a larger irrigation system that was previously operated by the plantations. Improvements to portions of the system and restoration of water to the irrigation system will enable agricultural production to increase.

B. IDENTIFICATION OF NEED AND EVALUATION OF EXISTING SOLUTION:

Inspections have been performed on these dams and reservoirs and corrections have been recommended. Each of the structures requires extensive work to bring the dams into compliance with the laws. The alternatives included full restoration, partial restoration or decommissioning of each dam and reservoir. In order to maintain the ability to impound water in the future, two dams will be partially restored and two dams will be decommissioned. The restoration of water to the system needs further evaluation.

C. ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND IMPACT IF PROJECT IS DEFERRED:

The alternative are to fully restore, partially restore, decommission or to do nothing. If nothing is done and the project is deferred these dams will not be in compliance with the law (Hawaii Dam and Reservoir Safety Act.) There will be a need to inspect, maintain, and to expend resources for fees annually for each dam. There will be potential for a failure of the dam should flooding conditions cause a breach or overtopping of the structure.

D. DISCUSS WHAT IMPROVEMENTS WILL TAKE PLACE, WHEN PROJECT COMPLETED (INCLUDING BENEFITS TO BE DERIVED AND/OR DEFICIENCIES THIS PROJECT INTENDS TO CORRECT):

Two dams will be partially restored. These dams will be improved and reinforced to meet the current standards required by law. These dams will be designed to retain less water than the current capacity. There will be a better ability to regulate flood water and increase safety. These dams will be capable of retaining water for agricultural or pastoral use. Restoration of portions of the irrigation system will convey more water to restored dams. Two dams will be decommissioned. These dams will be reconstructed to allow water to safely pass through the existing earthen berm without eroding the earth.

E. IMPACT UPON FUTURE OPERATING REQUIREMENTS (SHOW INITIAL AND ONGOING FUNDING REQUIREMENTS BY COST ELEMENT, INCLUDING POSITION COUNT, MEANS OF FINANCING, FISCAL YEAR):

The costs to maintain the existing dams and irrigation system is indeterminate at this time. The costs to complete emergency action to drain one of the dams after a period of extensive rain in 2012 was approximately \$180,000. This type of cost is episodic and can occur at any time. The correction of the deficiencies and decommissioning of two dams would eliminate this type of cost.

After the repairs are completed the annual cost to operate and maintain the two remaining reservoirs would be approximately \$50,000
