Status & Testimony	Imposes a state carbon emissions tax of \$6.25 per ton of carbon dioxide equivalent emissions on all aviation fuel. Directs the aviation fuel tax into the airport revenue fund. Implements a tax credit to mitigate the effects of this tax on lower income taxpayers.	,

Requires the Department of Transportation to plan for a certain amount of sea level rise in all future or amended transportation projects. Prohibits any person from using a public road, street, highway, or similar thoroughfare to transport endangered marine species harvested from state waters for commercial purposes and marine species harvested from state waters for commercial aquarium purposes (Proposed SD1).
