RELATING TO REAL ESTATE BROKERS.

Status & Testimony	Prohibits real estate brokers and agents licensed in the State from advertising, offering for rent, receiving any remuneration for, or representing illegal transient vacation units and wholehome short-term rentals. Requires the Real Estate Commission to amend its rules accordingly no later than 12/31/2022.	
SB 2513 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Requires the Public Utilities Commission to have electric utilities separately issue requests for proposals for firm renewable energy generation and requests for proposals for intermittent renewable energy generation. Prohibits the Public Utilities Commission from approving any new or renewed utility-owned generation project by a public utility or any new or renewed power purchase agreement for electricity generation with affiliated interests with a public utility. Appropriates moneys.	CPN/EET, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO DIGITAL CURRENCY LICENSING PROGRAM. Creates a licensing scheme for digital currency companies to be regulated by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs' Division of Financial Institutions.
